Kant taught morality as a matter of following maxims of living that reflect absolute laws. Universal is a term that allows for no exceptions, and what is universal applies always and everywhere. In your town the Crazy Murderer comes to your door looking for your friend and wanting to kill him. You know that your friend went home to hide. What do you tell the murderer?
